



Variegated Chinese Star Jasmine – *Trachelospermum tricolour*

This wonderful shrub/groundcover provides year round interest provided by its decorative foliage. Frost sensitive but drought tolerant once established. Is also used as a climber. Milky sap may cause skin irritation.

Height: 30-60cm **Width:** 3m

Form: Low growing shrub/groundcover **Foliage:** New growth emerges as a creamy white/pink. Mature foliage can vary from dark glossy green to mottled variegated foliage.

Flowers: Fragrant small white flowers in spring and summer.



Chinese Star Jasmine – *Trachelospermum jasminoides*

A favourite for its perfume and versatility as both a groundcover and a climber. Frost sensitive. Looks sensational when grown in a lattice pattern trained along wire. Milky sap can cause skin irritation

Height: 30-60cm **Width:** 4m

Form: Spreading climber/groundcover **Foliage:** Dark green glossy leaves

Flowers: White star-shaped flowers that produce a beautiful perfume from in spring and summer.



Rosemary – *Rosmarinus officinalis 'Prostratus'*

A hardy evergreen fragrant shrub with a prostrate habit. A groundcover version of rosemary.

Height: 30-50cm **Width:** 1.5m

Form: Prostrate with shooting stems **Foliage:** Dark green aromatic needle-like leaves arranged along the stem.

Flowers: Small mauve flowers in summer and autumn.



Common Everlasting Daisy – *Chrysocephalum apiculatum*

A fast growing perennial ground cover that cheers up the garden with it's delightful yellow button flowers. Suitable for a wide range of gardens. Keep moisture up in warmer months.

Height: 15-30cm **Width:** 60cm-1m

Form: Prostrate groundcover **Foliage:** Small silvery green leaves.

Flowers: Masses of golden circular balls appear a top of stems from spring to autumn



Native Violet – *Viola hederacea*

The Native Violet is a great little groundcover for shadier spots and makes a super filler for in between pavers. It can go dormant in severe conditions such as frost or drought, but will grow back.

Height: <15cm **Width:** 60cm-1m

Form: Dense groundcover **Foliage:** Green heart shaped leaves.

Flowers: Small purple and white flowers similar to pansies. Edible so can be used in cooking.



Fine Leaf Myoporum – *Myoporum parvifolium*

A widely available native evergreen groundcover that is fast growing in a wide range of growing conditions. Its foliage forms a thick mat which makes it great for erosion control and weed suppressing. Varieties to also consider include Broad Leaved Myoporum, Purple Leaved Myoporum and Pink Flowering Myoporum.

Height: <15cm **Width:** 1.5-2m

Form: Dense groundcover with upright stems **Foliage:** Very fine leaves.

Flowers: Small white star-shaped flowers in spring and summer. They are very lightly scented.



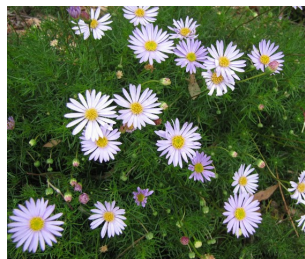
Pratia – *Pratia pedunculata*

A ground hugging perennial cover that thrives in damp soil. Fast growing, it's great for planting around pavers.

Height: 15cm **Width:** 1m

Form: Mat forming prostrate groundcover **Foliage:** Small soft green leaves.

Flowers: Masses of tiny white star-shaped flowers spring through to early summer



Cut-Leafed Daisy – *Brachyscome multifida*

A favourite of many gardeners due to it's versatility in many garden styles. This pretty perennial also comes in pink, deep blue and yellow flowering forms and will attract butterflies to your garden.

Height: 15cm **Width:** 60cm

Form: Mound forming groundcover **Foliage:** Soft fine leaves.

Flowers: Pretty daisy flowers appear form late winter to autumn.



Grevillea Gingin Gem – *Grevillea obtusifolia* 'Gingin Gem'

Hardy evergreen groundcover forming a dense mat of foliage and provides colour to the garden in winter. Will grow in a range of soil conditions but thrives in sunny, well drained spots. Bird attracting.

Height: 30cm **Width:** 3m

Form: Prostrate ground cover **Foliage:** Thin bright green leaves arranged densely around the stem

Flowers: Spider-like red flowers in winter and spring



Moses in the Cradle – *Tradescantia pallida* 'Purpurea'

This purple groundcover grows best in semi-tropical areas in mid to northern Australia. It is a great contrast plant and looks fantastic as a groundcover planted among silvery-grey foliaged plants

Height: 15cm **Width:** 1m

Form: Prostrate groundcover **Foliage:** Succulent like with narrow leaves.

Flowers: Tiny pink flowers in summer.



Running Postman – *Kennedia prostrata*

Running Postman is an eye catching groundcover that provides the garden with colour in winter. Mass plant for added effect.

Height: 10cm **Width:** 3m

Form: Spreading groundcover with trailing stems **Foliage:** Small silvery green.

Flowers: Masses of bright red little pea-like flowers in winter and spring.



Goodenia – *Goodenia ovata* Prostrate

This creeping version of Goodenia will grow in a wide range of soil types. It's really tough and great for landscaping projects such as erosion control and under tree planting. Frost and drought resistant.

Height: 20cm **Width:** 1m

Form: Dense groundcover **Foliage:** Small fleshy green leaves with double serrated margins.

Flowers: Bright yellow pea-like flowers appear from spring to summer.



Fairy Fan Flower – *Scaevola aemula*

A popular groundcover for rockery and cottage gardens because of it's long flowering season. White, pink, mauve and yellow flowering varieties available too.

Height: 20cm **Width:** 1m

Form: Spreading groundcover **Foliage:** Small green with serrated margins.

Flowers: Pretty fan-shaped purple flowers decorate the plant in spring to summer can also appear throughout the year.
