Description:

Classic evergreen shrub with small, glossy dark green foliage and abundant, single red blooms with showy yellow stamens. Flowers autumn to early winter. Widely used for hedging, in formal gardens, espaliers and in containers. Grows to approx 2.5m tall x 2.5m wide. Glowing red with prominent yellow stamens.

Cultural Notes:

Prefers well drained, humus rich soil with ph 5.5 - 6.5. Full sun to semi shade, mulch well as Camellias are shallow rooted. Prune after flowering if required. Fertilise with a Camellia specific slow release fertiliser late summer. Water well in dry periods.

Annual slow release fertiliser, Keep moist during dry periods
