### Description:

Deciduous, fruiting Pear tree that has fragrant white flowers in Spring followed by medium red sweet, juicy fruit. Fruit is great to use in deserts, preserving or to eat fresh. Requires a cross-pollinator to bare fruit. Many cultivars available.

### Cultural Notes:

Prefers a full sun position with well-drained fertile soil with a PH of 6 to 7.5. Water regularly until established, then provide an occasional deep water throughout the warmer months. Prune as required in Winter. Feed with manure and a suitable slow release fertiliser.

### Plant Care:

Annual slow release fertiliser, Keep moist during dry periods, Mulch well
