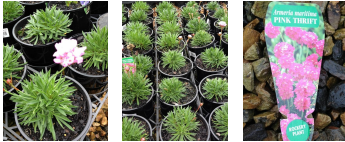

Description:

A small, pretty border plant with a prolonged flowering period perfect for adding a splash of colour to any cottage garden. Globe-shaped pink flowers sit above a tight, tufted mound of ornamental, grass-like foliage. A lovely drought tolerant choice for borders, containers and for bringing a splash of colour into the garden.

Removal of spent flowers will prolong flowering. Grows well in full sun in most soil types, does require good drainage. Low water requirements, but water well in extremely dry spells. Apply slow release fertiliser in late Spring.

Annual slow release fertiliser, Keep moist during dry periods
