Small compact perennial shrub with masses of beautiful single yellow daisy flowers. Suited to large containers or in the landscape. Grows approx. 50cm tall x 50cm wide.

Cultural Notes:
For growing in pots, use a good quality, well drained potting mix, that contains fertiliser. Do not allow plants to dry out. Prune plants when necessary to maintain shape and promote new flowers.

Annual slow release fertiliser, Keep moist during dry periods, Liquid feed, Mulch well
