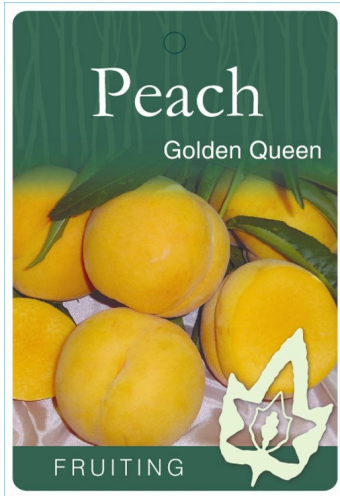


# Prunus persica Golden Queen

This peach produces medium sized round fruit with golden yellow skin. Flesh is orange and firm. High chill variety. Maturity: March (Late season). Used for bottling, preserves and drying. An upright growing tree producing heavy crops.

### Cultural Notes:

Plant in a sunny position with well drained and well worked soil. Take care to plant the bud union above the soil level. Water in well and keep soil moist until tree is established. Fertilise when planting and again after new growth appears. Prune tree when planting to encourage new growth.

### Plant Care:

Annual slow release fertiliser, Keep moist during dry periods, Mulch well
