**Description:**

Small low-growing perennial with hundreds of beautiful small long-lived yellow centred, white daisy blooms from Spring through Autumn. Easy to care for and great in beds or larger containers. Grows approx. 20-30cm tall x 45cm wide.

<b>Mature Width:</b>	30-60cm	<b>Soil Type:</b>	Loam, Sandy, Well Drained

**Landscape Use(s):** Borders / Shrubbery, Courtyard, Cut Flower, Feature, Formal Garden, Groundcover, Mass Planting, Container / Pot

**Pest & Diseases:**

Aphids, Generally trouble free

**Cultural Notes:**

Water well until established. Use a general slow release fertiliser in Spring. Remove faded blooms, should be removed regularly as it helps prolong flowering. Chrysanthemums benefit from winter protection.

**Plant Care:**

Annual slow release fertiliser, Keep moist during dry periods, Liquid feed, Mulch well
