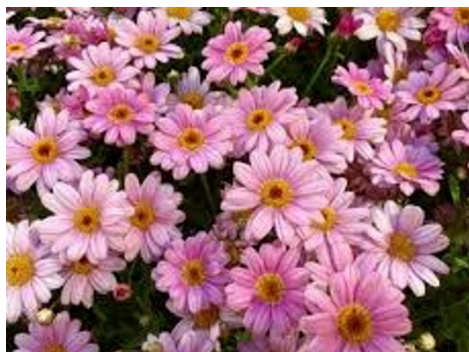


# Argyranthemum hybrida Sassy Mini Pink

**Botanical Name:** Argyranthemum hybrida Sassy Mini Pink  
**Common Names:** Marguerite Daisy, Paris Daisy, Federation Daisy,

**Description:**  
Very popular but short-lived perennial or shrub with clean mini pink daisy-like, orange centred flowers. Foliage is dark green, deeply cut and fragrant when brushed against. A bushy classic growing to approx. 40cm tall. Many cultivars are available, in single and double flowering forms. A great choice when you need a fast growing, flowering border plant.

Generally trouble free

**Cultural Notes:**  
Best in a sunny position planted in well-drained soil. Will tolerate some coastal exposure. Feed in Spring and deadhead when necessary. Cut back further in late Summer to promote another flush.

**Plant Care:**  
Annual slow release fertiliser, Keep moist during dry periods, Liquid feed, Mulch well
