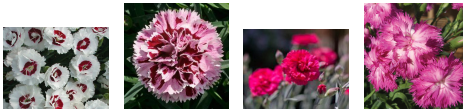
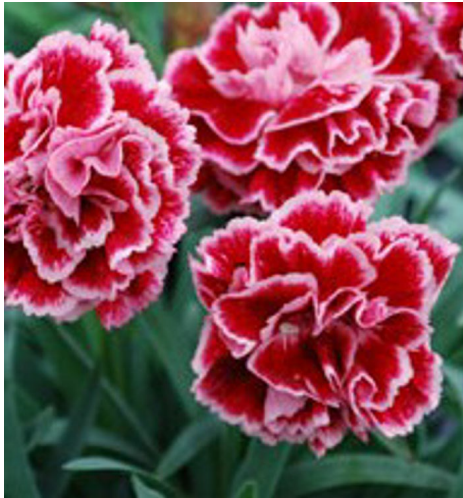

Annual slow release fertiliser, Keep moist during dry periods, Liquid feed, Mulch well
