Medium upright dense evergreen native shrub with masses of tiny star-like pink flowers from Winter through to Spring. Great for coastal and cottage themed gardens. Grows approx. 1m tall x 1.5m wide.

Prefers a full sun to semi-shade position. Water deeply in dry periods. Fertilise in Spring with a slow release fertiliser. Trim lightly after flowering. Tolerates most soil types and coastal conditions. Drought and frost tolerant once established.

Keep moist during dry periods, Low phosphorus slow release fertiliser, Mulch well
