Sedum Matrona is a beautiful upright herbaceous perennial. From spring to autumn stunning broad clusters of pale pink flower heads appear on tall purple stems giving absolute contrast to the blue green leaves. Looks great when mass planted and used with contrasting colours and textures.

Plant dies back in cooler weather. Cut off spent flower heads before new growth begins in early Spring. Can easily be divided. Watch out for Aphids and snails, they love the fleshy foliage. Liquid feed in the growing season.

### Plant Care:

Annual slow release fertiliser, Keep moist during dry periods, Liquid feed, Mulch well
