### Description:

Fast growing, low spreading perennial with masses of small, yellow, button flowers on the end of tall stems from spring to late autumn. A brightly coloured native that easily achieves the cottage feel. Grows up to 50cm H x 1m W.

### Pest & Diseases:

Aphids, Caterpillars, Generally trouble free

### Cultural Notes:

Generally trouble free. New growth may be susceptible to aphids and caterpillars may attack flowers. Mulch to maintain moisture in summer. May scorch in hot sun, will recover if pruned back. Trim off dead flower heads to encourage further flowering.

### Plant Care:

Keep moist during dry periods, Liquid feed
