Description:

Flowering native perennial growing up to 25cm in height. Beautiful purple daisy shaped flowers are present for most of the year. Great butterfly attractor. Useful for mass planting, borders, hanging baskets, retaining walls.

Plant 30cm apart for a mass display. Lightly prune to maintain a neat, compact habit. Water during dry periods. Tolerates frosts, leaves may burn, but will readily regenerate.

Keep moist during dry periods, Low phosphorus slow release fertiliser
