Description:

Compact small perennial with round variegated, ridged or stripy foliage and tiny, upright conical green or brown flower spikes during the warmer months. Perfect indoor plant.

Peperomia plants require a sheltered position and usually access to some sunlight. Read the plant label for specific requirements. Plant in a suitable container using a good quality potting mix. Fertilise twice a year with a slow release formula and a liquid feed as required.
