Prune after flowering to keep plant looking compact. Feed early spring with a low phosphorus slow release fertiliser. Drought tolerant once established. If planted in a container, use a good quality native potting mix.

Keep moist during dry periods, Low phosphorus slow release fertiliser, Mulch well
