Prefers well drained soil in a sunny position, but will tolerate part shade. A tough shrub tolerating most conditions and climates including pollution and salt. Responds well to heavy pruning. Great as a hedge if pruned often, 3-4 times a year. Fertilise in Spring. Plant 1 - 2m apart if hedging.

Plant Care:

Annual slow release fertiliser, Keep moist during dry periods, Mulch well
