Showy rounded short-lived evergreen perennial with large burgundy petunia flowers from Spring through to Autumn. Great for pots and makes a great groundcover in the garden. Often planted as an annual. Grows approx. 30-40cm tall x 30-40cm wide.

Cultural Notes:

Prefers a sunny position in a well-drained soil. When growing in pots, use a well-drained, organically rich potting mix. Plant 15-20cm apart for quick coverage and prune when required. Do not allow plants to dry out. For best results feed monthly with a suitable liquid fertiliser or with a balanced slow release fertiliser.

Plant Care:

Annual slow release fertiliser, Keep moist during dry periods, Liquid feed, Mulch well
