Description:

Ornamental Pears are deciduous trees with glossy green leaves that are highly valued for their spectacular autumn tones, clusters of open, cup-shaped, white flowers in spring and provide shade in the summer months. Any fruit is usually small and hard. Chanticleer is an upright, medium sized tree with a broad pyramid, to rounded shape and horizontal branching. Very attractive glossy, dark green leaves turn yellows red and oranges in autumn before leaf fall. Abundant white flowers clusters appear in spring. Grows approx height: 10m Width: 7m Great for feature planting, Avenue/Street planting, Screening, Hedging and Pleaching.

Cultural Notes:

These hardy trees are adaptable to most soils including dry and intermittently wet soils. Mulch to retain soil moisture and control weeds. Prefers a full sun position but will tolerate partial shade. Formative pruning as required, but not necessary. Water over warmer months until tree is established. Once established Ornamental Pears are generally drought hardy. Apply a Slow Release General Purpose Fertiliser in spring and autumn.
