Description:

A stunning, aquatic flowering sedge. Grows between up to 45cm tall. Green stems rise up from the water are topped with clusters of bright green thread-like stems arranged like balls. Green-brown flowers appear in summer followed by brown nutty fruits. Excellent architectural feature plant for smaller ponds, water features and containers.

Grow in full sun or partial shade around the edges of ponds or in small feature tubs in water approximately 10cm deep. Thin out and remove dead foliage as required. Keep moist. Looks stunning in glass fishbowls or large jars.
