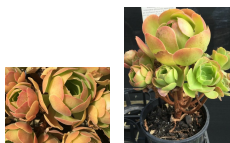
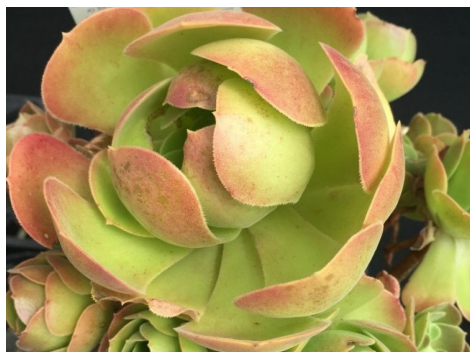


Aeonium hybrida Blush

This species of Aeonium grows to about 60cm high and develops a number of branches with rosettes of pink and green leaves. Great for containers or to plant in mass for colour contrast. Grows approx 60-90cm x 30-60cm.
