Part of the Bush Gem Range, Bush Pearl has masses of prolific pink flowers that sit neatly above strappy green foliage. Flowering throughout the year. This bird attracting Kangaroo Paw grows approx 60cm tall and 50cm wide. Useful for coastal plantings, cut flowers, borders and pots.

Cultural Notes:

Tolerates most soil types and coastal conditions. Protect from heavy frosts. Cut spent flower stems off at the base. Cut entire plant to base to refresh if looking tired. Water well in dry periods.

Plant Care:

Keep moist during dry periods, Low phosphorus slow release fertiliser, Mulch well
