An ornamental dense shrub to around 2-3m tall with small attractive wedge shaped leaves. Flowers are wine-red with dense cylindrical heads 20cm long in Winter, Spring and into Summer.

Performs best in a full sun position in a well-drained soil. It can handle a range of soil conditions and a front line coastal position. Tolerates moderate frost. Feed in Spring with a low phosphorus slow release fertiliser.

### Plant Care:

Keep moist during dry periods, Low phosphorus slow release fertiliser, Mulch well
