Description:

Very popular but short-lived perennial or shrub with clean daisy-like, yellow centred flowers. Foliage is dark green, deeply cut and fragrant when brushed against. A bushy classic growing to approx 60cm tall. Many cultivars are available, in single and double flowering forms. A great choice when you need a fast growing, flowering border plant. Double White has clean, double white flowers and a mounding habit.

Best in a sunny position planted in well drained soil. Will tolerate some coastal exposure. Feed in Spring and deadhead when necessary. Cut back further in late Summer to promote another flush.

Annual slow release fertiliser, Keep moist during dry periods, Liquid feed, Mulch well
