### Description:

An unusual slow-growing deciduous Maple with an upright habit. Foliage is green, lacy and fine. Leaves are deeply lobed giving the appearance of looking slightly fluffy. Leaves change colour to a beautiful bright yellow-orange in Autumn. Grows to 2m in ten years.

### Cultural Notes:

Prefers moist, well drained soil but will adapt to most. When planting, avoid disturbing the roots and use Seasol or Plantstarter to give them the best head start. Always use a quality potting mix if planting in a container. Feed in Autumn and Spring with a slow release fertiliser. Rarely needs pruning. Avoid over watering.

### Plant Care:

Keep moist during dry periods, Mulch well
