Description:

Dense, low growing, glossy green leaved Carpet Rose with masses of soft, white flowers in Spring through to Autumn. Flowers are lightly fragrant and stay clean even after rain. Drought tolerant once established. Useful for commercial and domestic gardens. May remain evergreen in warmer climates. As a mature plant, Flower Carpet® White grows to 60-70cm high and 90cm wide.

Cultural Notes:

No dead-heading required. Cut bushes back by two thirds in late winter. Grows best in well drained soil with added compost, but will tolerate most. Plant 2-3 per square metre, for ground cover. Plant 70cm apart to establish boundaries. Can be planted anytime during Spring, Summer or Autumn.

Annual slow release fertiliser, Keep moist during dry periods, Mulch well
