#### Description:

Attractive hardy small perennial. Geranium's are suitable for gardens all over Australia. Flowers throughout the warmer months with lovely single blue-violet blooms. Dense foliage ranges from mid to dark green with red veins. and has a great trailing to semi-trailing habit, some varieties have scented foliage. Great for hanging baskets and containers or plant in a garden bed for a stunning splash of colour. Available in a range of assorted colours.

#### Cultural Notes:

Remove spent flower heads to promote flowering. Add compost to soil twice a year, Autumn and Spring. Feed with a slow release fertiliser but do not use a high nitrogen one as this would promote more leaves and less blooms. Can mulch lightly with straw. In extremely dry weather, water deep once every fortnight.

#### Plant Care:

Annual slow release fertiliser, Keep moist during dry periods, Liquid feed, Mulch well
