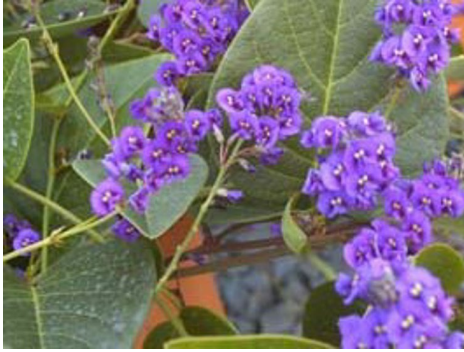

Vigorous native climber / trailing plant with dark green heart shaped leaves and masses of purple pea-shaped flowers appearing in Spring. Useful for densely climbing and covering walls and a effective ground cover. looks fantastic when planted on mass.

Shallow rooting and fast growing, Hardenbergias do not tolerate waterlogged soils. Prune regularly to shape and refresh growth. Will flower best if full sun.
