Description:

Dwarf, rounded Japanese maple that grows slowly to 3m in height. Beautiful new red foliage deepens to dark red then bright red in Autumn. Leaves are not dissected, clumped together and give a 'tufted' appearance. Great for small feature tree, contrasts well against green foliage. Also great in containers, group plantings and courtyards.

Prefers moist, well-drained soil in full sun to part shade. Protection required from hot, summer winds. Pruning is not generally. Mulch well to retain moisture. Transplants well in the dormant months.

Annual slow release fertiliser, Keep moist during dry periods, Mulch well
