No watering required once established if in suitable conditions. Water if very dry weather for long periods. Can prune to shape. Tip prune after flowering, this will encourage a better shape. Feed in early spring with a low phosphorus slow release fertiliser.

Plant Care:

Keep moist during dry periods, Low phosphorus slow release fertiliser, Mulch well
